Next, click *Library Links* and enter "University of California, Riverside" in the search box. Select the **check box** beside the university name in the results list, then click *Save*. This connects Google Scholar to our *UC-eLinks* service.

When you next search in Google Scholar, click on the *UC-eLinks* words [no icon] next to an article of interest to retrieve the full text.

If you don't see the words *UC-eLinks*, click on *more* and it should appear.
